

## **Telford & Wrekin Draft Rights of Way Improvement Plan**

Telford & Wrekin Council has produced a Draft Rights of Way Improvement Plan (Draft ROWIP) to meet the requirements of the Countryside & Rights of Way Act 2000. The document is a ten year strategic plan to manage the public rights of way network. The Draft ROWIP aims to improve the borough's public rights of way network and the provision for all users including walkers, cyclists, equestrian and people with mobility difficulties.

The Draft ROWIP has now been published for consultation until **30 April 2009**. The Council is seeking comments on the draft plan from users, parish councils, user groups, land managers and the wider public. Comments received will help shape the preparation of the final Rights Of Way Improvement Plan.
