Strine Internal Drainage Board

Minutes of the Meeting held on 11th April 2016 at Kynnersley Village Hall at 7.30pm.

1. Present:

2. Election of Chair

John Belcher proposed Bruce Udale as chair. There were no other nominations for the position. The nomination was seconded by Brian Crow; the board voted unanimously in favour. Bruce was duly elected as chair.

Election of Vice-Chair

Bruce Udale nominated John Belcher for the role of vice chair. There were no other nominations. The nomination was seconded by Richard Hockenhull and all voted in favour. John was duly elected as vice chair.

The election of board members

Seats on the board were not contested. John Belcher nominated Isobel Moseley to fill the vacant position on the board left by the sad death of Mike James. Richard Hockenhull seconded this and the board voted unanimously in favour. Isobel was duly elected onto the board.

5. Consideration of minutes of the previous meeting 11th January

Richard Hockenhull proposed that the minutes be approved as an accurate record of the meeting. This was seconded by Isobel Moseley

6. Matters arising from the minutes

Work on the trees in the River Tern was not completed due to the wet winter conditions. The contractor is waiting for dry weather and lower flow levels.

John, Bruce Colin and Kate met at the Aqueduct Syphon to consider how flooding issues could be reduced on site; development up stream of the syphon having the potential to put more pressure on the system. John Bellis attended from Telford & Wrekin Council. Bruce has since taken levels on site and found the banks to be very uneven. Reducing this unevenness will help prevent water spilling over from the Wall Brook into the Parson's Oak. There are trees which need to be removed to protect the syphon and also a tree down which is preventing the digger working the site. It was agreed that the board

should try to take measures before seeking funding from planners for syphon inspection & desilting. **ACTION:** JB will cut trees back on top of the syphon. A plan for the rest of the work will be considered later in the year.

The clerk received a briefing document from the NFU & ADA regarding the new Environmental Permitting Regulations and consents for work. The board considered the details presented but felt that more information was needed to understand the implications of the changes. **ACTION**: the clerk will find out more.

Himalayan Balsam was discussed. It is the riparian owners' responsibility to control this weed on their land. Identifying the plant before flowering is important. **ACTION:** the clerk will send out information on identifying and controlling the weed with rates demands in May.
