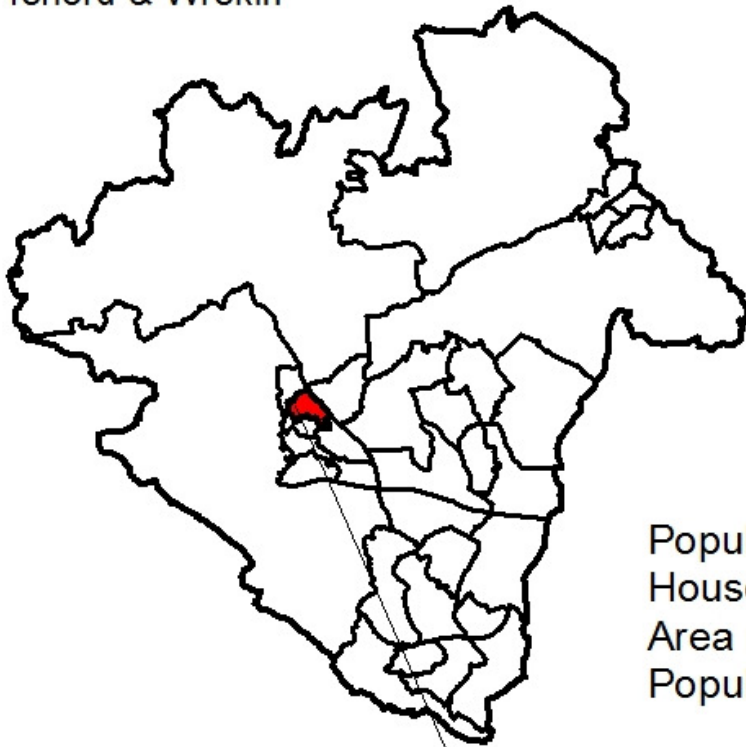
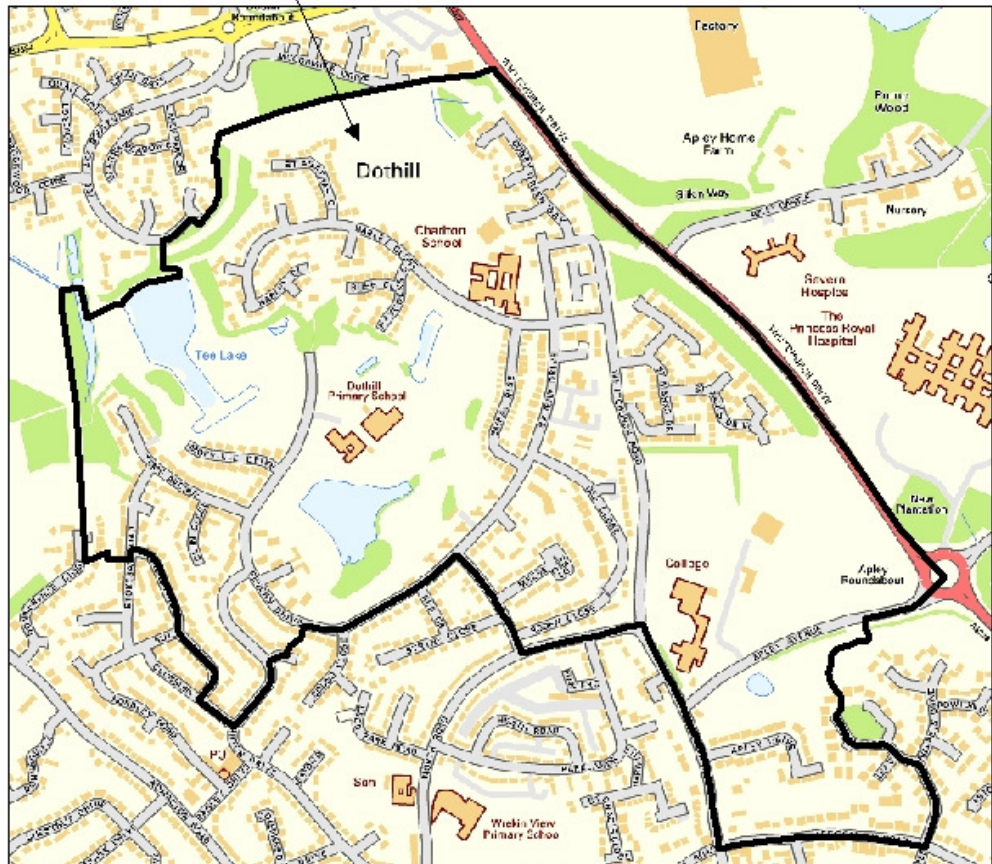

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# 1 Population Characteristics

**Summary:**

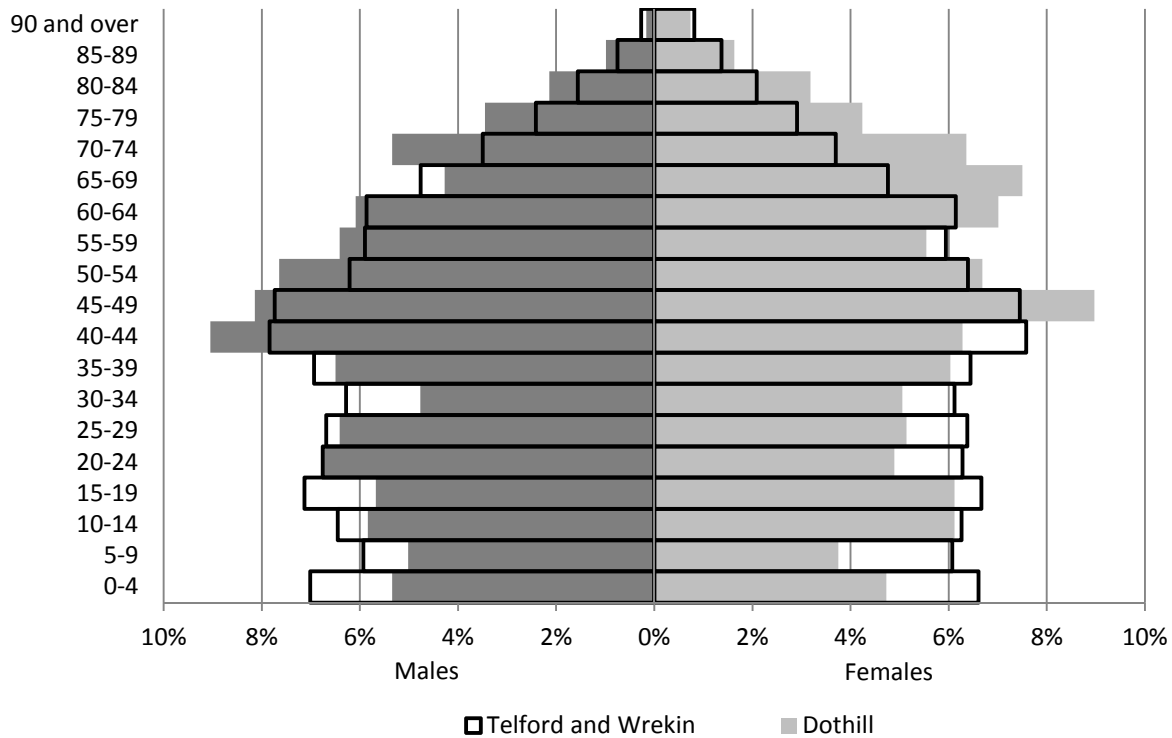
- Dothill's population decreased by 8.3% between 2001 and 2011.
- In the ten years prior to the 2011 Census, the 0-15 age group decreased by 22%, with those aged 16-24 and 25-44 increasing by 5.3% and 31.8%, respectively.
- The population aged 45 and over increased by 15.8% and is larger proportionally in Dothill than the Borough.
- Dothill's population is dominated by the 40-49 group, with higher proportions than Borough wide.

## 2 Diversity

### Summary:

- The BME population of Dothill grew by 10.5% between 2001 and 2011, accounting for 7.3% of the ward's total population, below that seen Borough wide (10.6%).
- The 'Other White' population increased by 2.9% and at 2.9% of the population remained the largest BME group in the ward.
- Although the proportion of Christians decreased from 77.4% to 66.7%, it still remained the largest religious group in the ward, higher than the Borough-wide figure (61.7%).
- For the first time in a census, people were asked for their main language. Out of the 2.6% of the population whose main language is not English, the majority can speak English well or very well (2.0% of the population), below the Borough-wide rate of 3.1%.

### 3 Household and family characteristics

**Summary:**

- The 2011 Census found 1,113 occupied household spaces in Dothill accommodating 2,424 people.
- One third (33.8%) of households in Dothill are one person households, the fourth highest ward rate in the Borough.
- Some 47.2% of households have access to one car or van, down from 48.9% in 2001, above the Borough rate (43.1%). The average number of cars per households is 1.19 compared to 1.27 Borough wide.
- The proportion of households deprived in at least one dimension decreased from 64.6% to 57.5% between 2001 and 2011 and is below the Borough rate of 58.3%.

## 4 Housing

### Summary:

- The number of household spaces in Dothill has decreased by 143 since 2001.
- The most common accommodation type in Dothill live is semi-detached house or bungalow (43.3%), higher than the Borough rate of 36.7%.
- Even though the proportion of households living in a purpose built flat, maisonette or apartment decreased considerably between 2001 and 2011, it is still more than double the Borough rate (8.6%).
- More than a third of households in Dothill (34.2%) own their home outright, compared to 27.2% Borough wide.
- The number of households in Dothill privately renting their home has doubled since 2001.

## 5 Employment and economy

### Summary:

- Between 2001 and 2011 the proportion of economically active population in Dothill remained the same at 69.9%, slightly higher than the Borough rate of 69.4%.
- Although the unemployment rate increased from 2.3% to 3.8%, it is still below the 4.7% Borough wide.
- A total of 5.7% of Dothill residents aged 16-74 have never worked, below the Borough rate of 7.2%.
- The proportion of residents employed in 'professional occupations' increased from 10.0% to 15.0% and is above the 13.9% Borough wide.
- The proportions of Household Reference Persons' across different social grades are similar to the Borough rates. Some 29.9% of Household Reference Person are classed as social grade DE Semi-skilled and unskilled manual workers / On state benefit, unemployed, lowest grade workers, slightly lower than the Borough.
- The proportion of residents who drive a car or van to work increased to 69.9%, just under the 70.0% Borough wide.
- Some 22.2% of Dothill residents aged 16+ have level 4 qualifications, higher than the 20.9% Borough wide.

## 6 Health and care

### Summary:

- Some 78.4% of people in Dothill reported good or very good health, compared with 80.2% Borough-wide.
- A total of 21.0% residents felt their day-to-day activities were limited by a long term health problem or disability, an increase since 2001, and higher than the 18.6% seen across the Borough.
- Some 11.5% of residents in Dothill provided unpaid care, slightly higher than the 10.8% seen Borough-wide.

## Notes and definitions

### Household deprivation

The 2011 Census categorises households on their deprivation across four dimensions

- Employment – Any member of the household aged 16-74 who is not a full-time student is either unemployed or permanently sick
- Education – No member of the household aged 16 to pensionable age has at least 5 GCSEs (grade A-C) or equivalent AND no member of the household aged 16-18 is in full-time education
- Health and disability – Any member of the household has general health 'not good' in the year before census or has a limiting long term illness
- Housing – The household's accommodation is either overcrowded (occupancy indicator is -1 or less) OR is in a shared dwelling OR does not have sole use of bath/shower and toilet OR has no central heating.

### Household Reference Persons

HRPs provide an individual person within a household to act as a reference point for producing further derived statistics and for characterising a whole household according to characteristics of the chosen reference person.

- For a person living alone, it follows that this person is the HRP.
- If a household contains only one family, then the HRP is the same as the Family Reference Person (FRP).
- If there is more than one family in a household, the HRP is chosen from among the FRPs using the same criteria used to choose the FRP i.e selected on the basis of their economic activity, in the priority order.
  - Economically active, employed, full-time, non-student
  - Economically active, employed, full-time student
  - Economically active, employed, part-time, non-student
  - Economically active, employed, part-time, student
  - Economically active, unemployed, non-student
  - Economically active, unemployed, student
  - Economically inactive, retired
  - Economically inactive, other
- If some are all FRPs have the same economic activity, the HRP is the eldest of the FRPs, if some or all are the same age, the HRP is the first of the FRPs from the order in which they were listed on the questionnaire.
- If a household is made up entirely of any combination of ungrouped individuals and other related families, the HRP is chosen from among all people in the household, using the same criteria used to choose between FRPs.
- Students at their non term-time address and short-term migrants cannot be HRP.

### Dependent children

A dependent child is a person aged 0-15 in a household (whether or not in a family) or aged 16-18 in full-time education and living in a family with his or her parent(s). It does not include any children who have a spouse, partner or child living in the household.
