Notice of Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order Section 119 Highways Act 1980 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, Section 53a (2) Footpath Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No.5 (Parish of Dawley Hamlets) 2019

The above Order, made on 5 September 2019, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed as made will divert the public footpath commencing at the junction with Restricted Byway 164 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SJ 67717 05864 the route being an unsurfaced enclosed path having a width of approximately 1.5 metres passes through a wicket gate and continues south-east for a distance of 38 metres to the wicket gate at the junction with Footpath 194 and Footpath 197 at OSGR SJ 67743 05840 to a route commencing at the junction with Footpath 194 and Footpath 197 at OSGR SJ 67743 05840 by the wicket gate the route being an unsurfaced path having a width of 2 metres continues generally west-south-west for a distance of 45 metres to OSGR SJ 67653 05821 then north-north-west for a distance of 15 metres to the junction with Restricted Byway 164 at OSGR SJ 67651 05829

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
