

TELFORD AND WREKIN COUNCIL FORTON ROAD (NEWPORT) (RESTRICTED ROADS 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019

Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin proposes to make the above named Order under Sections 82, 83 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be the Telford and Wrekin Council (Forton Road, Newport) Restricted Road (No. 1) Order 1999 shall cease to have effect insofar as it relates to the extent specified in Schedule One below and introduce a speed limit of 30mph along the length specified in Schedule Two below.
