

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ADMASTON & HIGH ERCALL, TELFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019
Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford and Wrekin in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act has made the following Order: TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ADMASTON & HIGH ERCALL, TELFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019

This order will come into effect on Thursday 31st October 2019.

1. When this Order comes into effect;

Waiting will be prohibited at all times on the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order to the extent specified.

Schedule

1. Pemberton Road, Admaston (both sides)	From the junction of Wellington Road for a distance of 39m in a south west direction
2. Shrewsbury Road, High Erccall (the south-west side)	From a point approximately 10m north-west of its junction with Church Road to a point approximately 22m south-west of its junction with Church Road
3. Wellington Road, Admaston (both sides)	From a point 78m north west of the centreline of Pemberton Road for a distance of 174m in a south east direction

Any persons wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act have not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
