

Unpaid carers 0-24

It is estimated that 1,600 people aged under 25 (2.8%) are unpaid carers with the largest proportion in The Wrekin (2.9%).

Unpaid carers 25-64

It is estimated that 13,000 people aged between 25 and 64 (14.4%) are unpaid carers with similar proportions across all three localities.

Unpaid carers 65+


It is estimated that 4,500 people aged 65+ (15.2%) are unpaid carers with the largest proportion in the Wrekin (16.3%).







