

## **Borough of Telford & Wrekin**

Notice of Confirmation of a Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order.

On the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2019 the Authority confirmed Footpath 49 Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order Parish of St Georges And Priorslee 1 Of 2019 made under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife And Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will divert Public Footpath 49 from its junction with Footpath 48 at grid reference 370945, 311111 where it continues in a general northerly direction having a width of 1 metre for a distance of 70 meters to grid reference 370940, 311174 then continues west-north-west for a distance of 65 metres to its junction with a stone path at grid reference 370742,311294 TO a route commencing from grid reference 370945, 311111 at the junction with Footpath 48 which continues north-west for a distance of 120 metres to a junction at grid reference 370742, 311294 as shown on the Order Map, and also provide for the required consequential amendment of the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Shropshire.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be seen free of charge at Addenbrooke House Ironmasters Way Telford from 9.00 am to 4.30 pm on Monday to Friday. Copies of the Order and the Order Map may be purchased there for £5.

The Order comes into force on the date of confirmation of the Order but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to questions its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground it is not within the powers of the above Acts or on the ground that any requirement of either Act or of any regulation made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under section 287 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 or Section 52A(7) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published make an application to the High Court.
