


## Disclosable Pecuniary Interests

<p>Every Member is required to register and disclose certain interests and those of their spouse partner or by the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners where they are aware of the existence of such interest:</p>	
<p><b>Employment, Office, Trade or Profession</b> Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried out for profit or gain by the member or by their spouse or civil partner or by the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners.</p>	<p>Environment Office Environment Agency</p>
<p><b>Sponsorship</b> Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the Council) made to the member during the 12 month period ending on the latest date referred to in paragraph 6 in the code of conduct for expenses incurred by them in carrying out their duties as a member, or towards their election expenses. This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.</p>	<p>NONE</p>
<p><b>Contracts</b> Any contract made between the member or their spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners (or a firm in which such person is a partner, or an incorporated body of which such person is a director<sup>d</sup> or a body that such person has a beneficial interest in the securities of<sup>ii</sup>) and the Council - (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and (b) Which has not been fully discharged</p>	<p>NONE</p>
<p><b>Land</b> Any beneficial interest in land held by the member or their spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners which is within the area of the Council.  'Land' excludes and easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not give the member or their spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners (alone or jointly with another) a right to occupy or to receive income.</p>	<p>7 Stirchley Village + land formally known as "Stirchley Stores"</p>
<p><b>Licences</b> Any licence (alone or jointly with others) held by the member or his/her spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners to occupy land in the area of the Council for a month or longer.</p>	<p>None</p>

<p><b>Corporate Tenancy</b> Any tenancy where ( to the member's knowledge)- (a) The landlord is the Council; and (b) The tenant is a body that the member, or their spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners is a partner of or a director* of or has a beneficial interest in the securities* of.</p>	<p>plot 8 Attachment - <del>None</del></p> 
<p><b>Securities</b> Any beneficial interest held by the member or their spouse or civil partner or the person with whom the member is living as if they were spouses/civil partners in securities of a body where – (a) That body (to the member's knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the Council; and (b) either- (i) The total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or (ii) If the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares in any one class in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest that exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class</p>	<p>None</p> 
<p><b>Further to the mandatory disclosure of the interests above members should also declare an interest in any of the following matters which relates to or is likely to affect:</b></p>	
<p>Any body of which the member is in a position of general control or management and to which they are appointed or nominated by the Council.</p>	<p>None</p>
<p>Any body: (a) exercising functions of a public nature; (b) directed to charitable purposes; or (c) one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy( including any political party or trade union) of which the member of the Council is a member or in an position of general control or management.</p>	<p><i>None</i></p> <p>a) Environment Agency b) None c) League Against Cruel Sports Unison Compassion in World Feeding.</p>
<p>Any gifts or hospitality worth more than an estimated value of £50 which the member has received by virtue of their office.</p>	<p>None</p>
<p><b>NOTES ON SENSITIVE INTERESTS</b> An interest is sensitive if you and the Monitoring Officer agree that its disclosure could lead to you, or a person connected with you, being subject to violence or intimidation. The Nature of your sensitive interest will not appear in the published register of interest but it may be recorded that you have a sensitive interest.</p>	
<p><i>I understand that I must write to the Monitoring Officer to tell him about any disclosure of a disclosable pecuniary interest made at a meeting which is not already included above within 28 days of making the disclosure.</i></p>

\* 'director' includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident.

\*\* 'securities' means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme with the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.
