Statement of Reasons

TELFORD AND WREKIN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, SUTTON HILL) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2020

Proposals

After a review of the existing waiting prohibitions and restrictions in Sutton Hill the Council is now proposing new waiting prohibitions in the form of no waiting at any time restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) along various roads in Sutton Hill. This review identified that these sections of highways would benefit from restrictions as part of a new Traffic Regulation Order with the aim of improving junction visibility, pedestrian safety and improvements in traffic flow.

The roads effected by this order are Great Hay Drive, Hilda Hooke Close, Maythorne Close, Reynards Coppice, Sandcroft, Selbourne, Shakespeare Way, Sheridan Way, Smallwood, Southfield, Southgate, Stokesay Link, Stonedale, Stretton Close, Summerhill, Sunnymead & Sutton Way.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The specific grounds which the Council are using for implementation of the proposed waiting Prohibitions and Restrictions above are the following sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- Section 1 (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads or for preventing the likelihood of any such dangers arising
- Section 1 (C) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- Section 1 (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
