#### **Central Telford Area Action Plan – consultation on Proposed Amendments under the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 as amended (Regulation 27 (e) )**

The Borough of Telford and Wrekin has now prepared proposed amendments to the Central Telford Area Action Plan. The examination of the document was suspended for a period of six months in order for the Council to undertake further work on the Plan.

Copies of the Proposed amendments to the Area Action Plan, and the accompanying Sustainability Appraisal, are available for inspection from 9<sup>th</sup> March 2010 and representations invited until 19<sup>th</sup> April 2010.
