Decision regarding application for designation of the Stirchley & Brookside
Parish Council area as a neighbourhood area

Borough of Telford and Wrekin (“the Council”) received from Stirchley & Brookside Parish Council an application under Regulation 5 for the Council to designate the area comprising the Stirchley & Brookside Parish Council area as a neighbourhood area within the meaning of section 61 G of the 1990 Act (see explanatory note below).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that on 30th January 2014 under section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and all other enabling powers, the Council has designated the administrative area of Stirchley & Brookside Parish Council as a neighbourhood area (for the purposes of section 61G (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended).

The name of neighbourhood area is the administrative area of Stirchley & Brookside Parish Council.
