

Telford and Wrekin Council Off-Street Parking Places - Oakengates Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that, on Wednesday 26th August 2020, Borough of Telford & Wrekin has made the Telford & Wrekin Council Off-Street Parking Places - Oakengates Order 2020 – under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of this Order is as follows:

1. The parking places subject to this Order (“the Parking Places”) are located in Oakengates, Telford on land at Oakengates Theatre and land off New Street, off Bridge Street, off Station Approach and off Limes Walk.
2. The Telford and Wrekin Council Off-Street Parking Places Order 2016 – Oakengates will cease to have effect in its entirety.
3. This Order shall come into force on Thursday 27th August, introduce arrangements for use of the Parking Places, introduce maximum permitted parking periods and introduce Penalty Charges for contravention of this Order.
4. Between 0700 hours and 1800 hours, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle, or a trailer towed by a vehicle, to wait in the Parking Place off Limes Walk, Oakengates for longer than 3 hours
5. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle, or a trailer towed by a vehicle, to wait in the Parking Places at Oakengates Theatre, off New Street, off Bridge Street and off Station Approach, Oakengates for longer than 24 hours
6. The Driver of a Vehicle towing a Caravan into a Parking Place and the driver of a Motorhome shall not permit the Caravan or the Motorhome to wait in a Parking Place between the hours of 23:00 hours and 06:00 hours
7. 8. Any persons wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act have not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for that purpose to the High Court
