COVID-19-related pupil absence A quick reference guide for schools

What to do if	Action needed	Return to school when
 Child or staff member has the main COVID-19 symptoms: High temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste 	 Do not come to school Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days Get a test call 119 or click https://www.telford.gov.uk/testandtrace 	If the test comes back negative *unless the child or staff member has been identified by Test & Trace as a close contact of someone who has had a positive COVID-19 test (prior to their symptoms starting)
anything Child or staff member tests positive for COVID- 19	 Do not come to school Parent/member of staff informs school Notify the HPH immediately https://www.telford.gov.uk/testandtrace Agree an earliest date for possible return – minimum of 10 days from date of onset of symptoms Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days 	After 10 days isolation if they are well enough NB return to school even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell as these symptoms can last for several weeks
Child or staff member tests negative for COVID-	 Agree remote learning for pupils Parent/member of staff informs school Discuss when child or staff member can come back to school (same day/next day) 	*unless the child or staff member has been identified by Test & Trace as a close contact of someone who has had a positive test

What to do if	Action needed	Return to school when
Child or staff member is ill with symptoms which are not the main symptoms of COVID-19	Follow usual school absence policy procedure – see symptom checker	After 48 hours following the last bout of sickness/diarrhoea if this is the cause of absence
Someone in child or staff member household has COVID-19 symptoms	 Do not come to school Parent/member of staff informs school Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days Household member to get tested call 119 or click https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test Inform school immediately about test result 	The test comes back negative.
Someone in child or staff member household tests positive for COVID-19	 Do not come to school Parent/member of staff informs school Agree earliest date for return – minimum of 14 days Household informs NHS Test & Trace 	The child/staff member has completed 14 days of self-isolation Unless the child/staff member develops symptoms and gets tested – see above for positive or negative results instructions
*NHS Test & Trace or Telford & Wrekin Council Health Protection Hub have identified my child as being in close contact someone with confirmed COVID-19	 Do not come to school Parent/member of staff informs school Agree an earliest date for possible return – minimum of 14 days self-isolation If the child develops symptoms https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test If they subsequently have a: negative test they still need to complete the 14 day isolation positive a new 10 isolation period needs to start 	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation. NB the self isolation should be 14 days even if the child subsequently develops symptoms and has a negative test result If the child tests positive they can return when the new 10 isolation period finishes

What to do if	Action needed	Return to school when
Child/member of staff has travelled and has to self-isolate as a period of quarantine	 Do not take unauthorised leave in term time Consider quarantine requirements and government advice when booking travel/returning from a destination where quarantine is needed Agree an earliest date for possible return Minimum of 14 days from return date Self-isolate the whole household 	The quarantine period of 14 days has been completed
Children or members of staff receive medical advice that they must resume shielding	 Do not come to school Parent/member of staff informs school Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again 	School inform parents that restrictions have been lifted and children/staff can return to school
A school bubble is closed due to a positive case COVID-19 or outbreak in school	 Do not come to school Children supported at home with remote education provided by school Affected children and members of staff will need to isolate for 14 days 	School will inform parents and members of staff when the bubble will be reopened
