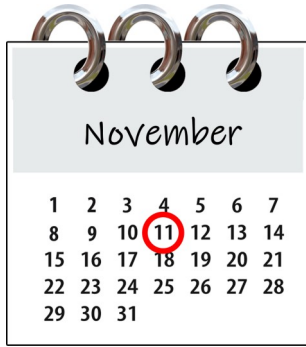

Then we will start to write the Adults with Learning Disability Strategy.



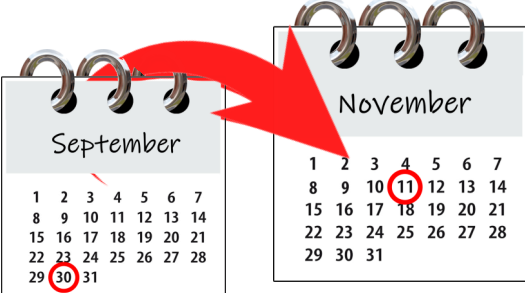

When we are writing the Adults with Learning Disability Strategy, we will work with lots of different people.
