

Statement of Reasons

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (FINGER ROAD AND SPRINGHILL ROAD, DAWLEY) (WAITING PROHIBITIONS) ORDER 2021

Proposals

To introduce waiting prohibitions to parts of the following roads: Finger Road, Portley Road, Springhill Road and Bush Lane.

After a review of the existing waiting prohibitions and restrictions in this area new waiting prohibitions are proposed in the form of no waiting at any time restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) on Finger Road, Portley Road, Springhill Road and Bush Lane. This review identified that these sections of highway would benefit from these restrictions as part of a new Traffic Regulation Order with the aim of preventing vehicles parking at these locations so to; improve visibility and safety for drivers when accessing and egressing the junctions, pedestrian safety (providing inter-visibility for pedestrians and other road users) and keeping the footways clear for pedestrian use.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The specific grounds which the Council are using for implementation of the proposed waiting Prohibitions and Restrictions above are the following sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- Section 1 (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads or for preventing the likelihood of any such dangers arising
- Section 1 (C) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- Section 1 (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
