

Temporary Road Closure - Sign Schedule



All signs are to be retro reflective and manufactured in accordance with the **Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.**

All signs are to be clean and legible with printed lettering and fit for purpose. Damaged, defaced or handwritten signs are not permitted.

- Sign No. 1 to be placed at each end of the closure Fourteen (14) days prior to the road closure commencing.
- **Sign No. 2** Placed at all advanced junctions where diversions will be needed to be signed from.
- **Sign No. 3** One sign to be placed at each end of closed section of road and at junctions or intersections within the closure.
- **Sign No. 4, 4a, 4b** to be placed only at start of the diversion alongside sign 3.
- **Sign No. 5, 5a, 5b** to be placed at every change of direction for traffic at junctions and where diversion continues past junctions.
- **Sign No. 6** To be provided at each end of the diversion.

No signage to be put in place without prior approval from the Streetworks Team (unless for Emergency works as defined in Section 52 of NRSWA).

Applicants are responsible for organising the provision and placement of signage and for the periodic checking and maintenance of signing during the period of the closure.

All signing to be removed and the road re-opened immediately once event/works are completed, or on agreed completion date, whichever is earlier.
