Update from TWSP Executive on 14 April 2021

Response to COVID-19 pandemic: The Executive has continued to monitor partners' response to the pandemic which has shown the strength of partnership working in Telford and Wrekin.

CQC report: Following inspection, on 26 February 2021, CQC served SaTH with an urgent notice of decision to impose conditions on their registration as a service provider in respect of regulated activities, under Section 31 of the Health and Social Care Act 2008.

The conditions make it clear that CYP should not be admitted to acute hospital settings with isolated mental health conditions; that supervision for those admitted should be available. It is not acceptable for CYP to remain in hospital once their medical needs have been met and they are medically fit for discharge due to mental health support not being available in a timely way. Additionally we are in agreement that unnecessary waits and delays for CYP experiencing mental health issues either attending at ED or awaiting discharge following an appropriate admission are unacceptable.

Significant progress is being made, with immediate arrangements in place to comply with CQC conditions.

There is further work required by system partners, including health and social care, to confirm sustainable solutions for the range of presentations and support needs and a senior leadership group is in place to take this work forward.

Review of TWSP arrangements

Following the review of the TWSP arrangements the Executive confirmed that 2 new Boards will be established, the Safeguarding Children Board and the Safeguarding Adult Board to ensure that there is a specific focus on the different statutory functions. Both Boards will report to the TWSP Executive and the Sub Group arrangements will report to Boards. Further details of the Board and Sub Group arrangements will be available once confirmed.

TWSP Risk Management

The Executive agreed that further work is needed to develop the TWSP approach to Risk Management. This will be considered by Sub Groups with ongoing monitoring through the Safeguarding Children Board and the Safeguarding Adult Board.

Learning Disability Consultation – last chance to have your say!

The consultation asks people to share views and examples on what more can be done for all people with a learning disability in Telford and Wrekin to live well and enjoy a full life, as independently as possible. The views will help to further shape the services and the support available in the borough for adults with a learning disability. In particular, the feedback received helps finalise a borough-wide draft five-year strategy for adults with a learning disability.
