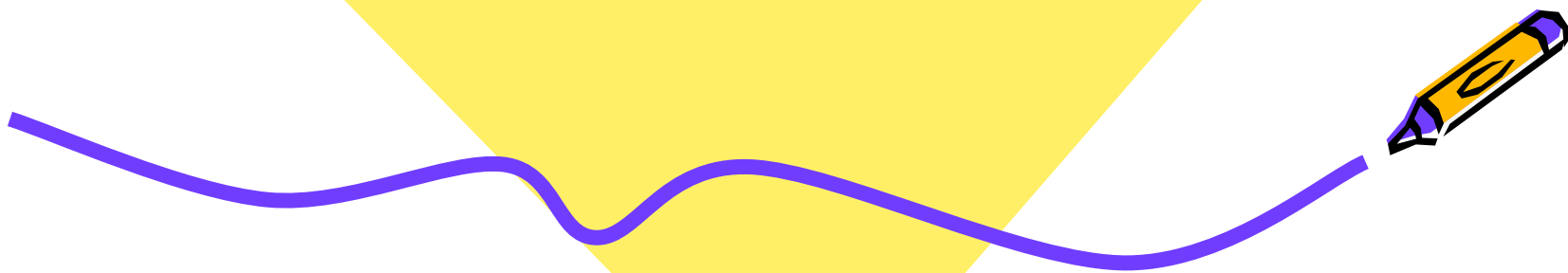


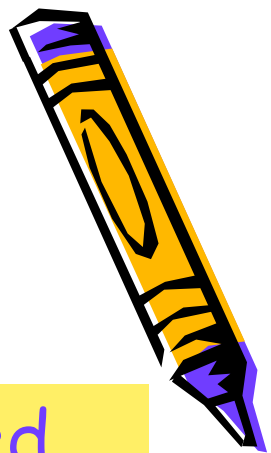
Christianity

Although there are many different types of Christians, they all believe in Jesus Christ.



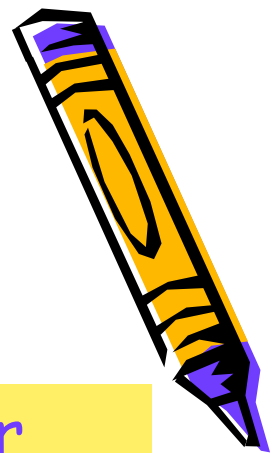
The Bible

- It is made up of 2 sections, The Old Testament and the New Testament.



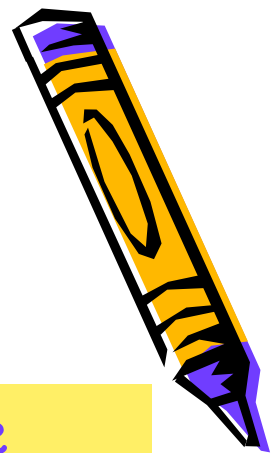
Symbols
