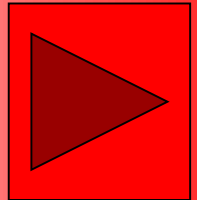


Jesus and His Disciples

The twelve disciples were called:

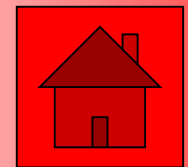
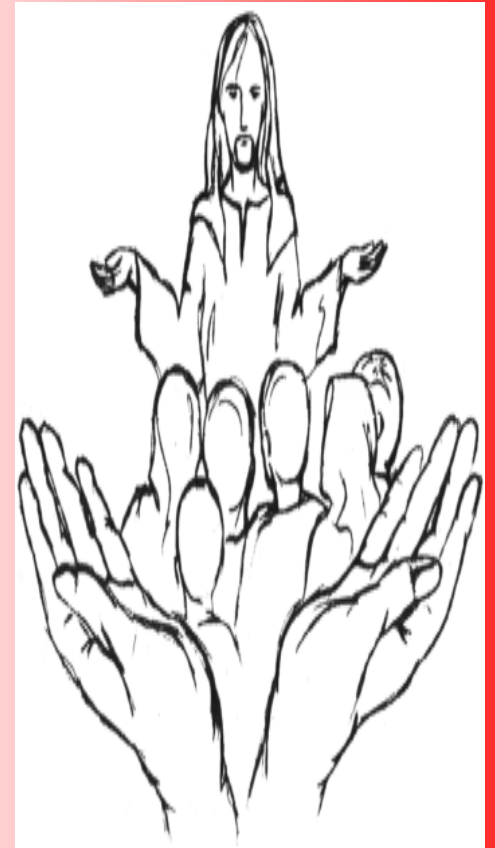
- Andrew - a fisherman.

- Judas - who betrayed Jesus.



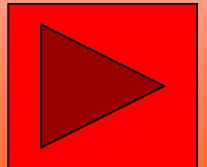
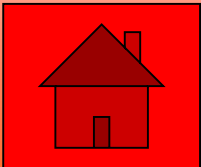
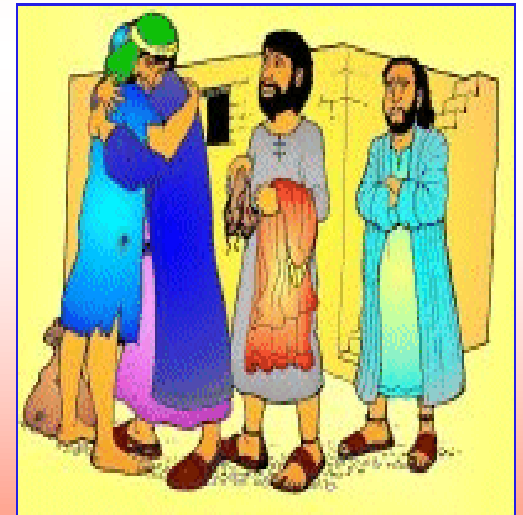

Many people came to hear Jesus when he preached in Galilee. Jesus wanted ordinary people to listen to him.

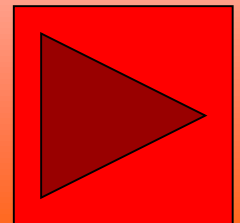
He used to preach in the open air. He didn't need a synagogue or temple.

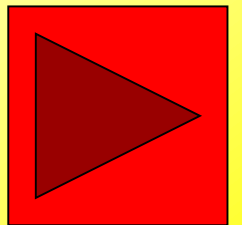


When someone asked Jesus what He meant by “love thy neighbour”, He started to tell him this story.

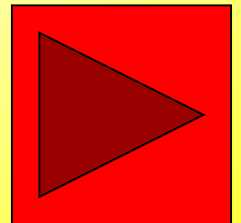
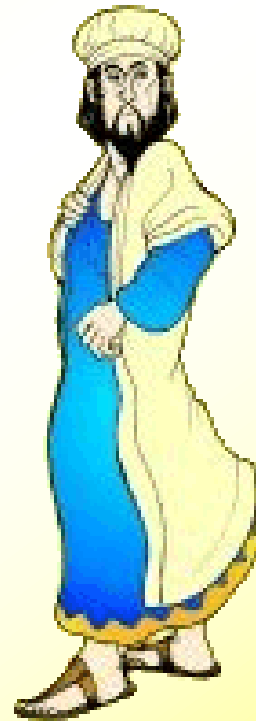
A Jewish man was travelling from Jerusalem to Jericho.



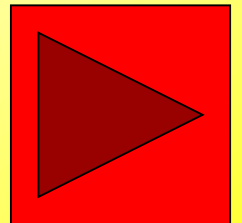
He was attacked by thieves on a lonely road. They beat him and stole his money and clothes. They left him to die.



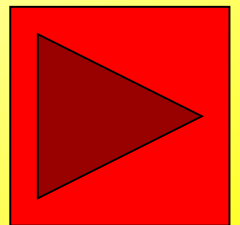
After a while a priest passed by. When he saw the injured man he crossed to the other side of the road and walked quickly away.



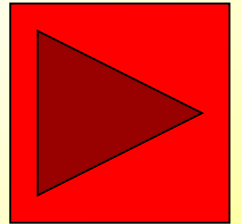
Sometime later another priest came along. He also saw the injured man. He also crossed to the other side of the road and walked quickly away.

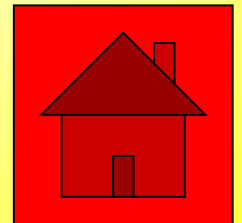


He put bandages on his wounds and lifted the man onto his donkey. He took him to an inn and looked after him there.



The next day the Samaritan gave the innkeeper some money. He asked him to look after the injured man.

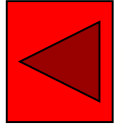

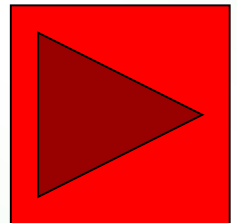


Jesus told this story to let people know how much God loved them.

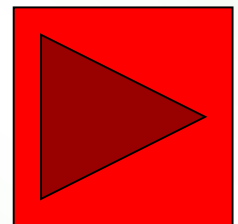
