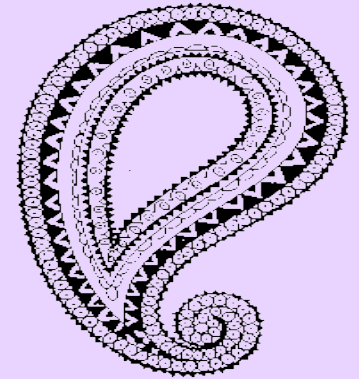
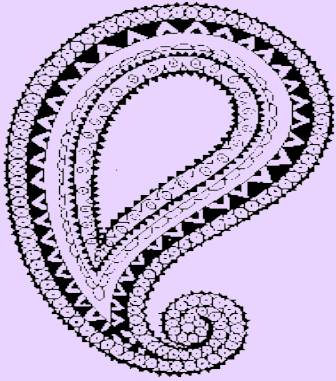

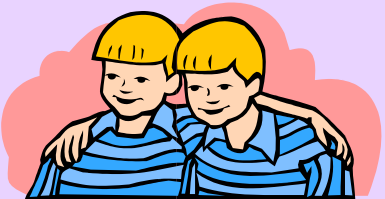
# Raksha Bandhan
