Having recently taught Judaism to Year 4 children, I became aware of the lack of resources for RE in general and so made these 2 sheets to help my class following an artefact handling session, where we looked at some of the items that Jewish males wear when they pray. I didn't include the 'tefillin' as it was quite conceptually difficult explaining all the different parts and why it was worn.

The sheets should be used in conjunction following a practical session or a video on prayer.
