- 1. How many Gods are there in Hinduism?
- 2. Describe who and what Brahman is?
- 3. Draw the symbol AUM or OM and describe its meaning?
- 4. Which Gods are the most common representations of Brahman? Draw one and label some of their features, try and give your own explanations and ideas about their importance?
