**The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 / The Accounts and Audit (Coronavirus) (Amendment) Regulations 2021  
Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014**

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 15(2)(b) of the Accounts and Audit Regulations (and the Amendment Regulations 2021) that from 14 June 2021 to 23 July 2021 on weekdays any person may inspect, and, on reasonable notice they may request access to make copies of the account, all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other related documents of the Council for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021, as stipulated in Sections 25 and 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection at Telford & Wrekin Council, Addenbrooke House, Ironmasters Way, Telford, TF3 4NT **by prior arrangement** which should initially be made by email to [corporatefinance@telford.gov.uk](mailto:corporatefinance@telford.gov.uk) or by telephone to 01952 380000. The accounts will be available on the Council's website ([www.telford.gov.uk/accounts](http://www.telford.gov.uk/accounts))

During this period, a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, or their representative, may question the auditor about the accounts, or make an objection to the accounts as set out in sections 26 and 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. Any objection, and the grounds on which it is made, must be sent to the auditor in writing, with a copy to the Chief Financial Officer, Ken Clarke, Telford & Wrekin Council, Addenbrooke House, Ironmasters Way, Telford, Shropshire, TF3 4NT. Any objection must state the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- i) any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to law; and
- ii) any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 to, the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.
