The above Orders, made on 4<sup>th</sup> August 2021, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the following public bridleways:

A Bridleway commencing at Grid Ref: SJ 61468 07736 at the junction with the publically maintainable, all purpose highway (Upper Farm Junction to Spout Lane) the route being a stone path having a width of 2 metres continues south-east for a distance of 255 metres to the junction with a public right of way at Grid Ref: SJ 61594 07526 then continues south-east for a distance of 200 metres to the junction with a public right of way at Grid Ref: SJ 61727 07385 then continues south-east for a distance of 70 metres to Grid Ref: SJ 61787 07347 then continues east-north-east for a distance of 205 metres to Grid Ref: SJ 61984 07383 then continues north-east for a distance of 115 metres to Grid Ref: SJ 62064 07450 then continues south-east for a distance of 220 metres to the junction with a public right of way at Grid Ref: SJ 62217 07339.

A Bridleway commencing at Grid Ref: SJ 62542 07495 at the junction with a public right of way the route being a stone path having a width of 2.5 metres continues south for a distance of 430 metres to the junction with Spout Lane to the west of Gibbons Farm at Grid Ref: SJ 62564 07058
