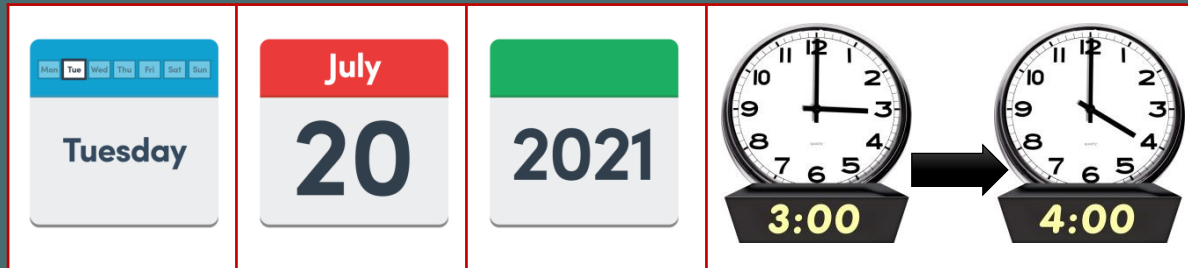

The most important actions to do include:

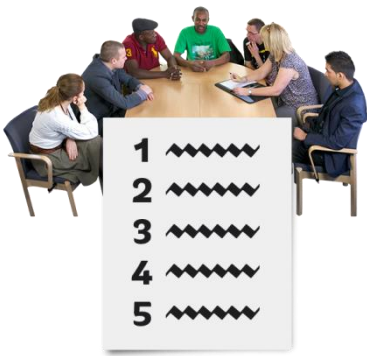
4 common themes for each area looked at in the consultation are:

Having Friends and Relationships

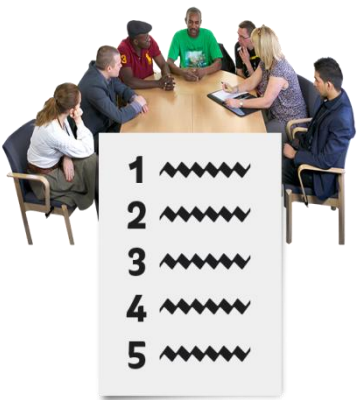
Link up with Telford Voices group.

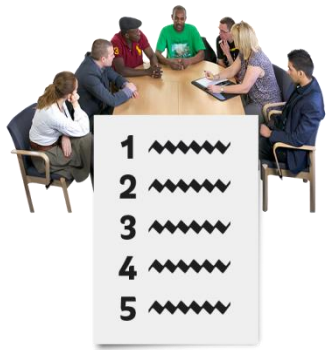

Learning Disability and Autism 3 year road map being developed. Led by Manny Jhavar-Gill for Telford and Wrekin.



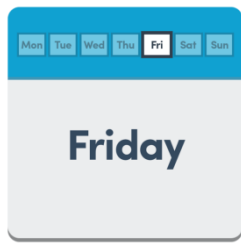
Impact of Covid: All 6 elements are key points.
