## Carriageway improvements in your area

### Resurfacing to improve the condition of your road

Dear Resident,

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads and footpaths, we will shortly be carrying out resurfacing to improve the condition of the highway on Admaston Road, Wellington

#### When are we planning to deliver this work?

The work is due to take place on 01<sup>st</sup> November and be completed within 3 Weeks (weekdays only), weather permitting. The works will be carried out under Phased Road Closures, and we will be working between 07:30-17:00.

- Removal of Existing Speed Cushions & Drainage Investigations – 01/11/21-03/11/21  
– Stop & Go Traffic Management
  - Resurfacing – 04/11/21-19/11/21 – Phased Road Closure
  - Phase 1 – 04<sup>th</sup>-05<sup>th</sup> Nov      Plane & Binder Course
  - Phase 2 – 08<sup>th</sup>-09<sup>th</sup> Nov      Plane & Binder Course & Civils Works
  - Phase 1 – 10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> Nov      Civils Works
  - Phase 1 – 15<sup>th</sup> Nov              Surface Course
  - Phase 2 – 16<sup>th</sup> Nov              Surface Course
  - Phase 1 & 2 (Alternated) – 17<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> Nov    Speed Cushion Installation
  - Phase 1 & 2 (Alternated) – 20<sup>th</sup> Nov Road Markings

- **Phase 1 is a closure from Wrockwardine Road to half way across the Elmpark Drive junction**
  - **Phase 2 is a closure from half way across Elmpark Drive junction to Donnerville Close**

Please note only one phase will be in place at a time. Two-Way Lights will also be in place on Elmpark Drive throughout the full duration of the works.

We will have our dedicated teams on site to assist you during this time to help you get past the working areas safely should you need to do. Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption, we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised, do not play near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.

#### Information about access to your property

Access will be maintained during the works for residents and for emergency vehicles although there will be short periods of time when the contractors will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded during planing of the road surface and to allow the surfacing material to harden. We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works.
