



Bellpit Road & Colliers Way Public Consultation

Background

Concerns have been raised by residents and Lawley and Overdale Parish Council regarding pedestrian and cyclist safety and the speed and type of vehicles using Colliers Way and Bellpit Road.

Data collected shows that the mean speed that vehicles are travelling along both roads is generally in excess of the posted 30 mph speed limit.

All of the injury collisions reported had the contributory factor 'failure (by drivers or pedestrians) to look properly' with two 'failing to judge the other person's speed or path'. Although none of the collisions were recorded to have a contributory factor of exceeding the speed limit introducing speed reducing measures may encourage compliance with the 30mph speed limit and reduce the impact and likelihood of collisions.

Proposals

As part of our investigations, we are proposing the following main interventions in the scheme area:

- Speed cushions
- Gateway signs and markings
- Bus stop marking and signs
