



Teaching Children with SEND: Meeting the Needs. 6 twilight sessions.

Who is it for?

All teachers are teachers of SEND

This course is applicable to anyone working in an educational setting with young children.

Delegates will:

- develop a good knowledge about the four broad areas of need and have an understanding of how quality first teaching can enhance access for all
- be given practical ideas on how to support learners in all aspects of the curriculum, including foundation subjects, handwriting, maths and memory skills
- have an understanding of how important it is to meet the social and emotional needs to ensure they are ready for learning, and how to build resilience to support children in their movement throughout the education system
- be better able to understand and use provision maps to enhance the learning for children in their class, whilst meeting statutory guidance

This course is unique, as you can buy into one or two sessions or attend all six at a reduced cost.

By attending all six sessions, the impact on professional development is at its best, and we hope to build links and partnerships between schools.
