The LSAT team having been working with our colleagues in the Shropshire Community Health Trust to explore how we can work together to support schools with SLCN provision and as a result are planning to offer 'ICAN TalkBoost KS1' training to schools before Easter.

Following some funding bids, we are hoping to be in a position to be able to offer this **free of charge** to all Infant, Junior and Primary schools in Telford and Shropshire.

What is TalkBoost KS1?

Talk Boost KS1 is a targeted intervention for 4-7 year old children with language that is delayed, including children in Reception classes. The programme is delivered in primary schools by classroom teachers and teaching assistants and provides a structured programme that boosts children's progress in language and communication

by an average of 9 - 18 months after a ten week intervention.

Why should you sign up?

As previously communicated, The Speech and Language Therapy team are moving towards a graduated response model which, for some children, will involve collating evidence of having implemented one of the recognised screening and intervention tools prior to referral:
