## Borough of Telford and Wrekin NOTICE OF NEW SPEED LIMITS TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, WROCKWARDINE) (20MPH, 30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

**Notice is hereby given** that Borough of Telford and Wrekin Has Made the above named Order under Sections 82, 83 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order will come into effect on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2022. The effect of the Order will be to revoke existing Orders listed in Schedule 4 to this Order and introduce a speed limit of 20mph, 30mph and 40mph speed limits along the following lengths of roads described in the Schedules 1 to 3 to this order.

Schedule 1 - 20mph	
From its junction with Wrekin View in a southerly direction for a distance of 34 metres.	
From its junction with Tiddlecross Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.	
From its junction with South View in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 79 metres.	
Entire Length	
From its junction with The Avenue in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 198 metres.	
From its junction with South View in an easterly direction for a distance of 120 metres and in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Station Road.	
From its junction with Blacksmiths Lane in a westerly direction to a point 28 metres west of its junction with Davids Bank.	
Entire Length	
From its junction with Wrekin View (Cul-de-sac) in a south-westerly direction to a point 167 metres	
north-west of its junction with Burcot Junction.	
Entire Length	
From its junction with Station Road in a north-westerly direction to a point 46 metres north-west of its junction with Tiddlecross Lane.	
Schedule 2 - 30mph	
From a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Tiddlecross Lane in a south-easterly and then a south-westerly direction to the godcake island junction with Wrekin View.	
From the godcake island junction with Davids Bank in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 314 metres.	
From its godcake island junction with Davids Bank in a westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres.	
From a point 34 metres south of its junction with Wrekin View for a distance of 285 metres.	
From a point 79 metres south-east of its junction with South View for a distance of 555 metres.	
From a point 120 metres east of its junction with The Avenue godcake island in an easterly direction for a distance of 314 metres.	
From its junction with Rushmoor Lane in an easterly direction to a point 167 metres west of its junction with Blacksmiths Lane, Wrockwardine.	
Entire Length	
From a point 295 metres north-east of its junction with Back Lane in a southerly direction to its junction with B4394.	
From a point 428 metres south-west of its junction with B4394 in a south-westerly direction to a point 198 metres north-east of its junction with The Avenue.	
From a point 15 metres south of its junction with B4394 to a point 46 metres north-west of its junction with Charlton Junction, Wrockwardine.	
From a point 28 metres west of its junction with Davids Bank in a westerly direction for a distance of 371 metres.	
Schedule 3 - 40mph

From a point 28 metres south-west of its junction with B4394 in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 400 metres.	
<ul><li>From a point 28 metres south-west of its junction with B4394 in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 400 metres.</li><li>From a point 55 metres west of its junction with Station Road to a point 167 metres west of its junction with Blacksmiths Lane.</li></ul>

Any persons wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act have not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for that purpose to the High Court.

The Speed Order is intended to modify speed limits to help with safety on rural and village roads and is linked to developments in the area. On Rushmoor Lane the change of the speed limit from 30 to 40mph is 295 metres north-east of Back Lane, this is in line with the advertised plan.
