TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (HAYGATE ROAD, WELLINGTON) (INTRODUCTION OF A ZEBRA CROSSING) NOTICE 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Telford & Wrekin Council ("The Council"), in exercise of its powers conferred by Sections 23 and 25 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to establish a pedestrian zebra crossing with controlled areas on the following length of road specified in the schedule to this Notice.

The proposal is as follows: -

Schedule – Zebra Crossing	
Haygate Road, Wellington	The centre of crossing is located approximately 115.5 metres north-east of its junction with Herbert Avenue. The crossing with its controlled areas covers an approximate length 41 metres.

- 1. The zebra crossing has controlled areas (zig-zags) on both sides of the zebra crossing point. These controlled areas will have standard 8 zig-zags on either side of the crossing area, except for the north east side of the road approaching the crossing for the south west. This section will only consist of 6 zig-zags. This ensure that the controlled area on that side of the road, fits in-line with the construction and layout of the road network.
- 2. The Zebra Crossings will take the form as described in Schedule 14, Part 2, item 52 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (As amended).
