## Telford and Wrekin Council (St. Matthew's Road and Bradley Road, Donnington) (Prohibitions of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022

**Notice is hereby given that the Borough of Telford and Wrekin** in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby propose to make the following Order.

  - Waiting will be prohibited at all times on the roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order to the extent specified.

2. Ash Lea Drive, Telford and Wrekin (the south-west side)	From its junction with Bradley Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
3. Bradley Road, Telford and Wrekin (the north side)	From a point 85 metres north-east of its junction with St Georges Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 38 metres.
	From the centreline Ash Lea Drive in a south- easterly direction for a distance of 12.5 metres.
	From the centreline with Ash Lea Drive in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
	From the boundary of Nos. 32/30 in a north- easterly direction. for a distance of 32.5 metres
4. Bradley Road, Telford and Wrekin (the south side)	From the boundary of Nos. 32/30 in an easterly direction for a distance of 29 metres.





	From the edge of the building of No. 2, in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 38 metres.
	From the boundary of No. 8, in a northeasterly direction for a distance of 31 metres.
5. Eastwood Drive, Telford and Wrekin (the east side)	From its junction with Bradley Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
6. Eastwood Drive, Telford and Wrekin (the west side)	From its junction with Bradley Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
7. St Matthews Road, Telford and Wrekin (the north side)	From the boundary of Nos. 121/123, in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 66 metres.
8. St Matthews Road, Telford and Wrekin (the north-west side)	From a point 43 metres north-east of the prolongation o the centreline for the junction of Penistone Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 27 metres.
9. St Matthews Road, Telford and Wrekin (the south-east side)	From a point 43 metres north-east of its prolongation of the centreline of Penistone Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 27 metres.
10. The Common, Telford and Wrekin (the north-east side)	From its junction with St Matthews Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 8 metres.
11. The Common, Telford and Wrekin (the north-west side)	From its junction with St Matthews Road in a northerly direction to a point 8 metres.
