



Colliers Way/Bellpit Road - Road Safety Scheme Consultation

Background

Concerns have been raised by Ward Members and residents regarding pedestrian and cyclist safety and the speed and type of vehicles using Colliers Way and Bellpit Road.

Speed data collected shows that mean speeds generally exceed the existing 30mph speed limit along both Colliers Way and Bellpit Road. 85th percentile speeds on Colliers Way exceed this threshold on enforcement. Therefore, measures are being proposed to mitigate the excess speed on Colliers Way. It is also proposed to implement a 20 mph Zone to parts of Colliers Way and Bellpit Road.

This scheme aims to address the issues relating to vehicle speeds as well as improving safety for pedestrians and cyclists.

Proposals

As part of our investigations, we are proposing the following main interventions in the scheme area:

- Introduce physical traffic calming measures
- Gateway features
- Advisory cycle lanes
- Bus stop markings and signs
