Course Content

- ◆ Understanding barriers to learning and how to overcome them
- ◆ The inclusive classroom: what this looks like and how to ensure your own classroom reflects this.
- ◆ Working with Teaching Assistants: effective deployment of additional adults to ensure optimal progress of pupils with SEND.
- ◆ Provision maps: an overview to look at provision maps for your own pupils

What's in it for you?

- ◆ This course is designed to support teachers in delivering quality first teaching to all children, including those with SEND. It will include strategies and practical techniques that can be used on a lesson by lesson basis.

Key Outcomes:

- ◆ Delegates will be able to understand the needs of SEND in the classroom and how to support these needs effectively.
- ◆ Delegates will begin to develop an understanding of what is and is not SEND
- ◆ Delegates will know the responsibilities of the class teacher in relation to SEND and how these are complemented by SENCOs and TAs
- ◆ Delegates will be able to identify barriers to learning and know where to go for help in overcoming these.
