

**BOROUGH OF TELFORD & WREKIN (B5061 HOLYHEAD ROAD AND FOREST GLEN, THE WREKIN) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022**

Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin are proposing to make the above named Order under Sections 82, 83 and 84, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

The effect of the Order will be to modify and introduce a speed limit of 40mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to the Order. The Orders listed within Schedules 2 below will be revoke:

**Schedule 1**

**40mph**

Column 1	Column 2
Item No.	Length of Road
1	HOLYHEAD ROAD From a point 13 metres south-west from the centreline of the junction for New Church Road in a south-westerly direction to the junction with Forest Glen.
2	HOLYHEAD ROAD B5061 TO CLUDDLEY JUNCTION From its junction with Holyhead Road/Forest Glen in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 105 metres.
3	FOREST GLEN TO JUNCTION 7 M54 From a point 325 metres north-west of its junction with Ercall Lane in a north-westerly and then a northerly direction following the kerb alignment to its junction with Holyhead Road.

Raised by the Parish Council, the proposal is to look at providing a consistent safe speed limit for traffic along the road of B5061 between New Church Road and a point 325 metres north-west of Ercall Lane. As part of a review of the area, we propose to introduce a reduction to the speed limit of a de-restricted road to a 40mph speed limit. In addition, update and redefine the existing speed limit of 40mph listed in the two Orders shown in the Schedule of Revocation.
