

Telford and Wrekin Council (Horton Lane) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 2022

Borough of Telford & Wrekin (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), Regulation 23 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Order (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulation 1996 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order.

This order shall come into operation on 20th day of June 2022 and may be cited as Telford and Wrekin Council (Horton Lane) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 2022.

1. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed within the length of road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - a. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - b. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - c. the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water company in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - d. the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the propose which it is being used on that occasion.
 - e. the vehicle to be used for the purpose is authorised by and with the permission of the Council.
4. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
