**PROVISION OF TRAFFIC CALMING (SPEED CUSHIONS) NOTICE 2022**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Borough of Telford & Wrekin in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultations in accordance with section 90C of the Act and Regulation 3(1) of the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999) intends to install road humps along the lengths specified in Schedule to this Order.
2. The road humps will be:
  - a. 1800mm wide, 3000mm in length and 75mm high;
  - b. 1600MM wide, 2000mm in length and 65mm high.

These road humps shall be precast, rubber speed cushions.

<b>Schedule 1 – Road Humps</b> <b>1800mm x 3000mm x 75mm</b>	
Bellpit Road, The Rock, Telford	From a point approximately 30 metres west of its junction with Mossey Green Way roundabout.
Colliers Way, The Rock, Telford	From a point approximately 10 metres north of its junction with Rock Road.
Colliers Way, The Rock, Telford	From a point approximately 57 metres east of its junction Woodrush Heath.

<b>Schedule 2 – Road Humps</b> <b>1600mm x 2000mm x 65mm</b>	
Colliers Way, The Rock, Telford	From a point approximately 13 metres north of its junction with Old Park roundabout.
Colliers Way, The Rock, Telford	From a point approximately 107 metres east of its junction Woodrush Heath.
