(PARISH OF RODINGTON)**

The above Order, made on 21 September 2022, if confirmed as made will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by extinguishing the footpath from SJ 58885 14505 at the junction with the highway and Footpath 3 by a kissing-gate the route being an undefined path having a width of 1 metre continues north across a garden area for a distance of 25 metres to SJ 58882 14535 at a kissing-gate.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
