RCGP Veteran Friendly GP Practice Accreditation Scheme

About 5% of the UK population are military veterans and have specific medical needs sometimes different from the general population. Veterans may be reluctant to seek help or talk about their problems, which means they do not always access care, support and treatments that are available. Others may face difficulty getting the right help. Veterans may think 'civilians' do not understand military culture or know about options for help and services that are available.

Experience has shown that General Practitioners (GPs) would like more help and support when looking after veterans. The Royal College of General Practitioners has developed the 'Veteran Friendly GP Practice Accreditation Programme', which involves a simple online process of accreditation where practices are required to meet the specified criteria and provide evidence that they are supportive of veterans' healthcare. The aim is to improve healthcare provided to veterans and their families by GPs working in primary healthcare. The Telford & Wrekin Strategic Armed Forces Covenant Partnership Board is pleased to invite you to sign up for a briefing on the **Royal College of General Practitioners' 'Veteran-Friendly Accreditation programme'**. The session will be held via Teams on **Thursday 8th December 2022 at 2.15PM**.

The session will be presented by Brigadier Robin Simpson. Robin is the RCGP's veterans champion and he works with NHS England to accredit GP practices as 'veteran friendly'. Robin will present on the programme, how it works, what it does and how organisations and individuals can help promote it, with time at the end for a Q&A to discuss how this programme can further support veterans in the community.
