

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (NAIRD LANE, TELFORD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin Has Made the above named Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order will come into effect on 31 day of December 2024. The effect of the Order will be to introduce a prohibition of driving of motor vehicles the following lengths of roads described in the Schedule to this order.

Schedule

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Item No.	Length of Road
NAIRD LANE TO SHROPSHIRE BOUNDARY	From a point 33 metres east of its junction with Eliot Close in an easterly direction to a point approximately 20 metres east of the administrative boundary.

Any persons wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act have not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for that purpose to the High Court.

The purpose of the proposed Order is to remove motor vehicles from this length of road and give priority to both pedestrians and cyclists.
