



Hinkshay Road Public Consultation

Background

Concerns have been raised by Cllr Shaun Davies, Cllr Kuldip Sahota, residents and Great Dawley Town Council regarding the speed of traffic using Hinkshay Road.

Data collected shows that the mean speed that vehicles are travelling along Hinkshay Road are within the posted 30 mph speed limit though the 85th percentile¹ is higher through the middle section.

There have been no personal injury claims within the review in the last 5 years. Although there have been no recorded collisions, introducing these measures would reduce the potential of injury in view of the recorded speeds.

Cllrs Davies and Sahota have provided resources from their local Pride fund allocation to provide two speed indicator devices which will be erected as part of the scheme

Proposals

As part of our investigations, we are proposing the following main interventions in the scheme area:

- Priority Give Ways (build-outs)
- Speed Cushions
- Footway Improvements
- Parking Restrictions
