

Statement of Reasons

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (NEW STREET, NEWPORT) (ONE-WAY STREET RESTRICTION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

Proposals

It is proposed to amend the exiting One-way Street Restriction on New Street, Newport.

It is proposed to amend the one way street restriction on New Street so that it runs from the High street to a point just north-west of the entrance to the local off street car park. This is an approximate distance of 113 metres. The direction of travel remains the same from north-east to south-west.

The amendment to help with the free flow of traffic, in addition to access and egress from the off-street car park.

This proposal has been requested from Parish and Ward Councillors.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The specific grounds which the Council is using for implementation of the proposed parking restriction above are the following sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

- Section 1 (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads or for preventing the likelihood of any such dangers arising
- Section 1 (c) to facilitate the passage on the roads or any other roads of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
- Section 1 (f) to improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
