PVI Provision Ensuring Curriculum Progression and Depth.

The Curriculum lies at the heart of what we do and defines our intentions for children by detailing what we want them to know, understand and be able to do.

Using the EYFS Framework as an overview, educators have the responsibility and autonomy to shape, design and implement a curriculum that meets the needs of the children they work with and empowers them as learners and thinkers.

In this session Jan will establish the principles and practicalities for developing an appropriate curriculum that ensures progression and, depth for all children.

Squiggle me into a writer, including Dough Disco.

Wiggle me into a Squiggle is for the youngest of our early writers (age 2+). Its movement and messy play based, using specific movement to assist gross motor development.

Squiggle Whilst you Wiggle is mark making, movement and letter formation. Then we step into Squiggle me into a Writer linking our phonics into movement based letter formation.

Done throughout Early Years and Year 1 the writing of your children will improve significantly.



JAN DUBIEL

“Jan Dubiel is a nationally and internationally recognised specialist in Early Childhood Education.”

He was recently identified by the Times Educational Supplement as one of the ten most influential people in British education.

Having trained as an Early Years specialist, Jan worked as a Nursery, Reception and Year 1 teacher and Senior Leader. Following roles as an Early Years Consultant and Senior Adviser, he was appointed by the then Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA) to lead on the management of the (Early Years) Foundation Stage Profile, and had national responsibility for its implementation and moderation, developing guidance and support materials and working at a strategic level with policy makers. Most recently he was the Head of National and International Development at Early

Excellence where he was responsible for developing EExBA, used by 12,000 schools as a Baseline Assessment, EExAT, a Birth to 7 tracking system and EExAQ, an international qualification for Kindergarten teachers.

He is currently Director of Early Years for AISL Harrow International schools and Bilingual Kindergartens and project director for hey! at Hempsall's.

Jan has developed a national and international reputation as a conference speaker, consultant and trainer and he has written widely on different aspects of Early Years policy ,pedagogy and practice. His first book “Effective Assessment in the EYFS” was published by SAGE in 2014.
