Where is the role based?	We have opportunities at Southwater, Wellington, Madeley and
	Newport Libraries.
What is the aim of the role?	The aim of the role is to lead a 30-minute singing and rhyme session for babies and children under 5 with their parents/carers. The sessions help children develop speech and language skills in a fun way and also has positive benefits for maternal mental health. This is an opportunity to make a difference to somebody's day and have fun while you're doing it. A Standard DBS check will be required.
What would I be expected to do?	The main task is leading the group in singing and actions for a variety of nursery rhymes and songs. You would also set up and tidy away the area and promote the library service.
What training will I be offered?	There will be a full induction, including the opportunity to familiarize yourself with a variety of nursery rhymes and songs.
What kind of person are they looking for?	 We are looking for someone friendly, enthusiastic, and reliable with good communication skills who enjoys working with the under 5s over 18 years of age
How much time would I need to commit to the role?	A Bounce and Rhyme session lasts for 30 minutes and you will need to allow preparation and clear up time, so approximately 1 hour per session. There is flexibility to volunteer weekly, fortnightly, or monthly. All of the sessions are in the morning starting at 10.30am, Tuesday to Friday, across the venues. What support would I be given?	You will have a named member of staff as a contact and be invited to quarterly volunteer meetings to discuss how your role is going. There are always other staff in the library when a session is taking place, and all children are accompanied by a parent or carer.
