PROPOSALS FOR PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

- Proposed diversion of Severn Valley Way (footpath and informal cycle route)

DRAINAGE FEATURES

- Drainage / attenuation pond
- Improved field drainage / swales
- Improved field drainage where localised vegetation trimming may be required

STABILISATION FEATURES

- Rock revetment, locally enhanced with bio-engineered features
- Soft bank stabilisation, largely comprised of bio-engineered features
- Piling corridors

PLANTING

- LE 2.1 Native woodland planting
- LE 2.3 High forest
- LE 2.6 Shrubs
- LE 2.7 Scattered trees
- Japanese Knotweed (JKW) remediation bunds planting only carried out once clear of JKW

HABITAT CREATION

- LE 1.3 Species rich grassland
- LE 6.4 Marsh & wet grassland
- Temporary bat commuting screens
- Areas of existing Giant Horsetail, to be translocated into finished LE 6.4 areas
- Areas of other existing notable plants, to be translocated into finished LE 2.1 areas
