

## The Perry Way

The north Telford footpath/cycleway links Wellington and Donnington. The Perry Way provides a direct, traffic free route between residential and industrial areas suitable for commuting and leisure journeys.

The route follows the Shropshire Union Railway for 2½ miles. The Railway was opened in 1849 and ran from Wellington to Stafford.

The Perry Way is named in memory of a keen local cyclist and was opened by the Mayor of Telford & Wrekin in April 2004.

Stephen was a passionate believer in the need for a sustainable transport system. He campaigned for more than 20 years in the Telford area for improved cycle provision and against a car based transport policy.

He was a founding member of Telford Friends of the Earth and was co-ordinator of the group.

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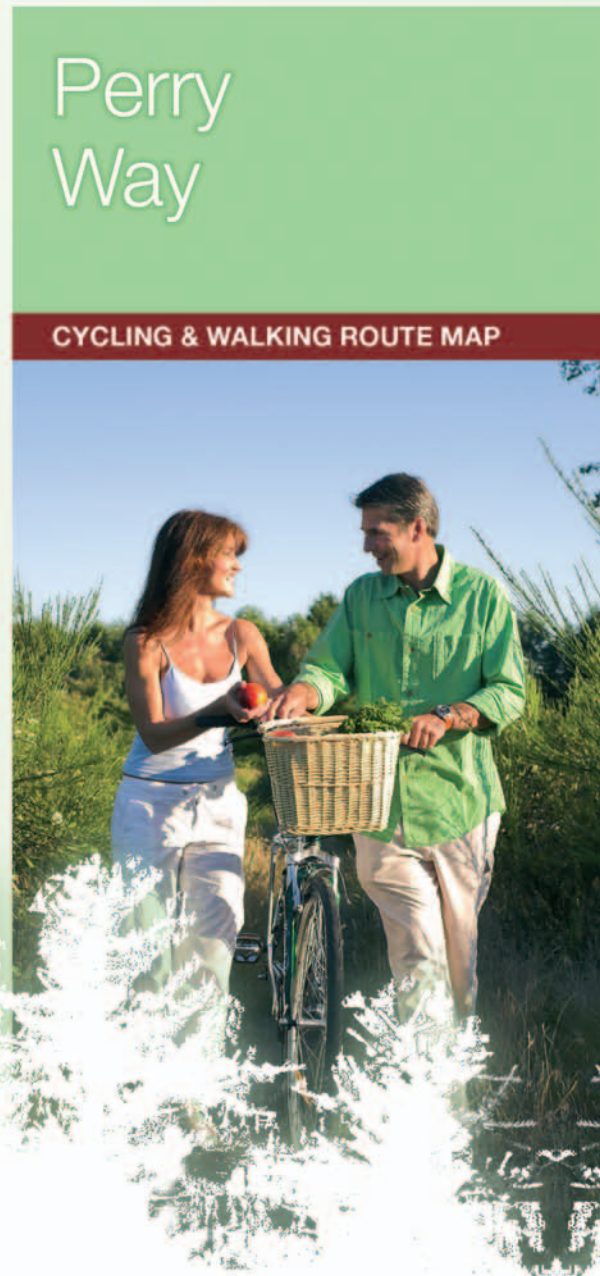

An easy walk of 2.5 miles distance. The location of the walk within the borough is indicated below.

**Route Description**

- Start at the underpass and head south towards Haybridge Industrial Estate. Follow the path to the left and under the underpass
- Follow the path to Leigate Avenue. **(Cyclists are required to dismount here to pass over the bridge. This is for your own safety and that of other users of the route).** Turning right follow the path up over the road, at the first fork keep to the left, at the next fork keep to the left and follow the path adjacent to Britannia Way
- Take the first left turning off Britannia Way, into un-named road, and follow the path to the right
- At Castle Lane follow the path to the left and follow the cycle/walking route
- Follow the path to the right and continue to Trench Lock Interchange. Follow the path to the left and continue to the pedestrian crossing. Cross here and continue to cross the next three pedestrian crossings, being careful of the busy roads and rejoin the path to the left
- Follow the path to the left and alongside the A518 to Hortonwood Roundabout.
