OVERVIEW


Wrockwardine Wood & Trench ward is located towards the centre of the Borough.

The 2011 Census found a total ward population of 6,679 with 14.0% of these residents from a BME background, higher than the 10.6% Borough wide.

Deprivation levels in Wrockwardine Wood & trench are not high with the most deprived area of the ward ranking in the 20-30% most deprived of areas nationally.

The rate of households claiming housing or council tax benefits is similar to Borough wide, with a lower proportion of children eligible for free school meal and children living in poverty.

Educational attainment in Wrockwardine Wood &



trench is higher than average across all key stages with 68.8% of Key Stage 4 pupils achieving 5 GCSEs A*-C including English and Maths compared to 55.0%.

Rates of crime and antisocial behaviour in the ward are below the Borough average for all categories.

Satisfaction levels are similar to Borough wide for four of the five measures with a higher 83% of residents agreeing that their area is a place where people from difference backgrounds get on well together (75% Borough wide).

DEPRIVATION

The table below shows the levels of deprivation within the ward. Each ward is broken down into smaller areas called SOAs (see the map above) and each area is given a national deprivation rank using the following scale:
