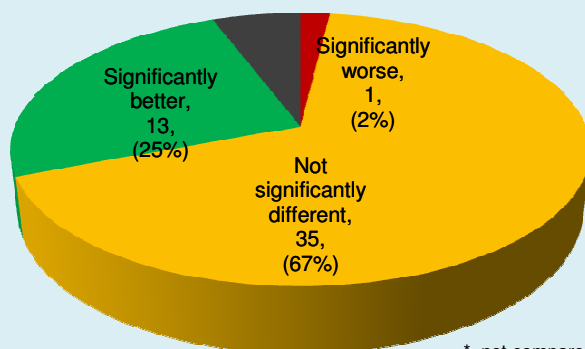


Ward Health Profile 2014: Apley Castle

Overview

• The health of people who live in Apley Castle Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Apley Castle compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



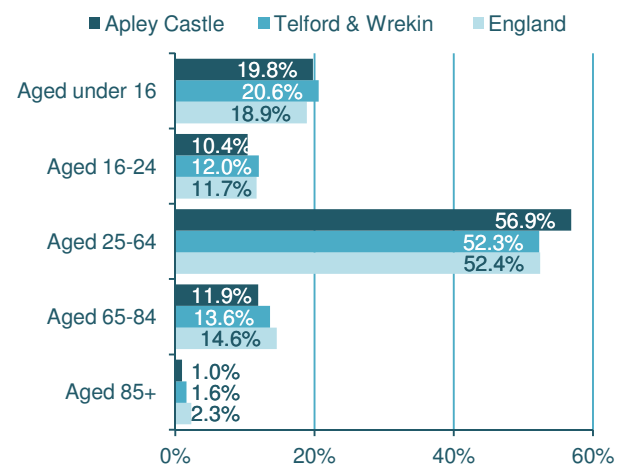

- The proportion of people aged between 25 and 64 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England.
- The proportion of people aged 65 and above in Apley Castle is lower than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England.
- Apley Castle is one of the least deprived wards in the borough. Levels of income deprivation and child poverty in the ward are significantly better than the average for England and part of the ward is ranked in the 10% least deprived areas in England. However, the proportion of older people living in deprivation is significantly worse than the England average.
- Emergency hospital admissions and incidences of cancer in the ward are not significantly different from the England average.

Life expectancy



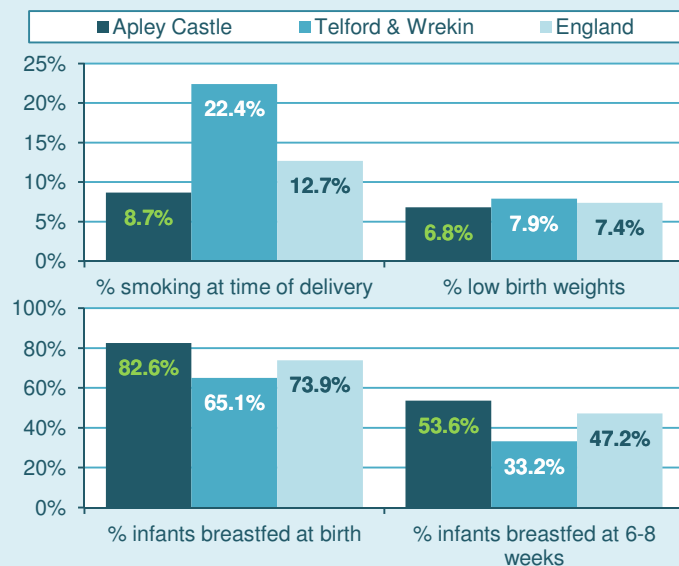

Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

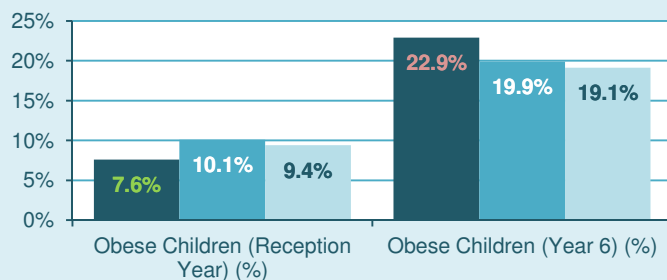
- The proportion of low birth weight babies (6.8%), mothers breastfeeding at birth (82.6%) and at 6-8 weeks (53.6%) is better than the borough and England average.

The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (8.7%) is better than the England average and is the third best rate in the borough



Childhood obesity

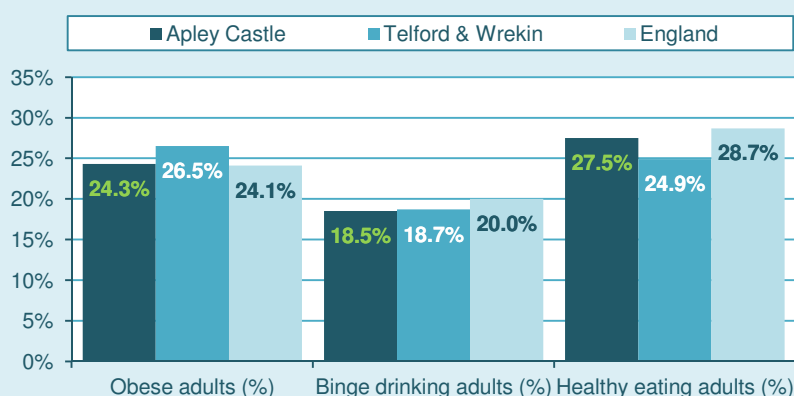
- Reception year obesity levels (7.6%) are better than the borough and England average.
- Obesity levels in year 6 children (22.9%) are worse than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The proportion of adults who binge drink (18.5%), level of adult obesity (24.3%) and healthy eating (27.5%) is estimated to be better than the borough average and statistically similar to the England average.



Smoking cessation

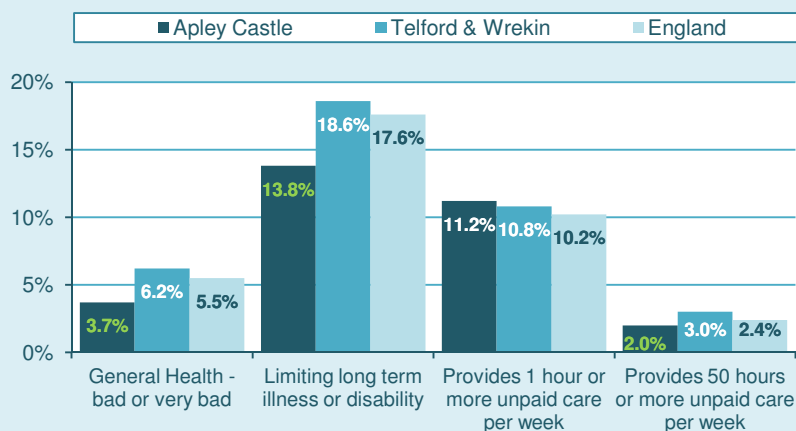
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme between September 2013 and August 2014 (36%), is worse than the borough average (56%).

(36%)**



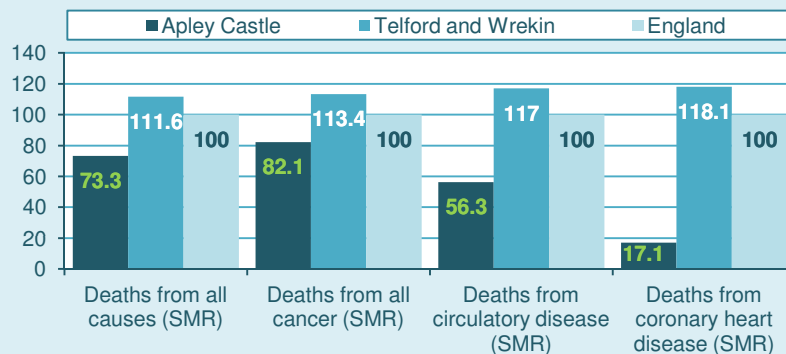
Health and Care

- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (3.7%), long term illnesses or disability (13.8%) and providing 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (2.0%) is better than the borough and England average.
- The proportion of people who provide 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (11.2%) is statistically similar to the England average.



Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Apley Castle is significantly better than the borough and England average for:
 - all causes
 - all cancer
 - circulatory diseases
 - coronary heart disease

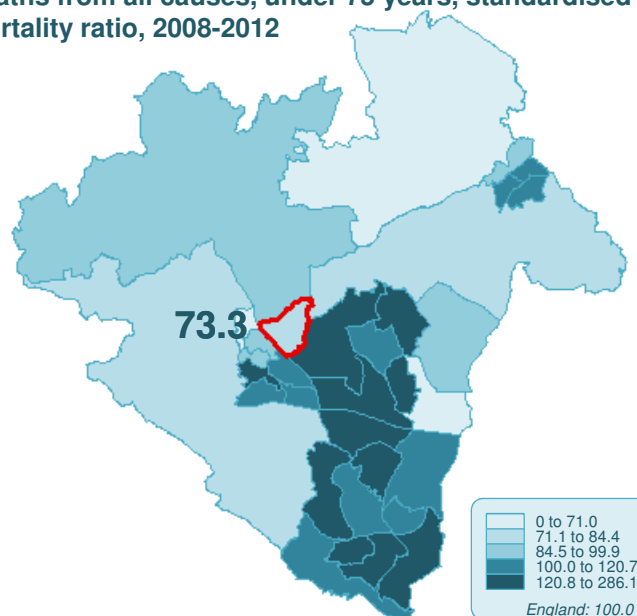


Apley Castle has the fourth lowest rate in the borough for early deaths from all causes (73.3).

This compares with the average early mortality ratio for Telford and Wrekin of 111.6, the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the England average of 100.

The ratio of early deaths from coronary heart disease (CHD) is the best in the borough. This ratio also means that Apley Castle is ranked in the 100 wards in England with the best ratio of early deaths from CHD.

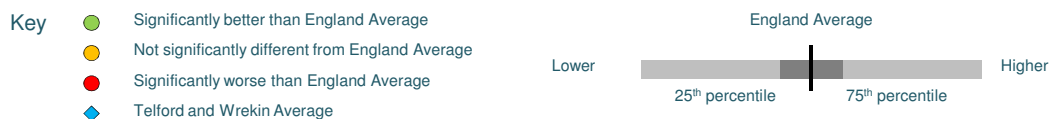
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
