
Ward Health Profile 2014: Arleston

Overview

• The health of people who live in Arleston Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Arleston compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.





- The proportion of people aged under 16 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is similar to the average for Telford & Wrekin and England. For women it is better than the borough and England average.
- Arleston is ranked among the most deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England. More than one fifth of people in the ward live in income deprived households, 3 in 10 children under 16 years live in poverty and almost one quarter of older people are in deprivation.
- Emergency hospital admission rates from all causes and from coronary heart disease (CHD) are significantly worse than the borough and national average. The admission rate from all causes is the fifth worst in the borough and is the fourth worst in the borough for CHD.




Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (20.3%) and breastfeeding at birth (66.7%) is better than the borough but worse than the England average.
- The proportion of low birth weight babies in Arleston (10.7%) is worse than the borough and the England average.


The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (33.3%) is similar to the borough but significantly worse than the England average.



Childhood obesity

 Childhood obesity levels are worse than the borough and England average.


The level of Year 6 obesity (31.7%) is the worst in the borough.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult binge drinking (15.2%) is estimated to be better than the borough and the England average.
- Adult obesity (24.8%) and healthy eating (25.3%) levels are estimated to be better than the borough but worse than the England average.



Smoking cessation


The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months from September 2013 (47%) is worse than the borough average (56%).



Ageing Well

Health and Care

- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (5.9%), long term illnesses or disability (18.5%) and providing unpaid care for one or more hours per week (10.2%) is similar to the borough and England average.
- The proportion of people providing 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (3.2%) is worse than the borough and England average.





Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths among people in Arleston aged under 75 from circulatory disease is better than the borough and England average.
- The ratio of early deaths is similar to the borough average and statistically similar to the England average for:
 - · deaths from all causes
 - · deaths from all cancers
 - · deaths from heart disease

The ratio of early deaths from circulatory disease (68.9) is the fifth best in the borough.

Arleston is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes. The ratio of early deaths in Arleston (111.4) is similar to the average for Telford & Wrekin of 111.6, and compares with the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the England average of 100.
